The position

Physical education classes are a part of our shared programs. Lessons are taught in English with students from OIS and SIS studying together. This means that students of varying English levels will be in the classes.

The PE curriculum includes team sports, racquet sports, swimming, track and field, dance, synchronized swimming, gymnastics, etc. It also includes fitness, strength and conditioning, and health education. IB Middle Years Programme unit planners are used.

We are looking for a teacher who loves teaching, is passionate about health and fitness, and can work in a multicultural environment. You must be able to teach in English and include some English as an Additional Language techniques in your teaching. Some Japanese language ability would be beneficial.

Salary & Benefits
